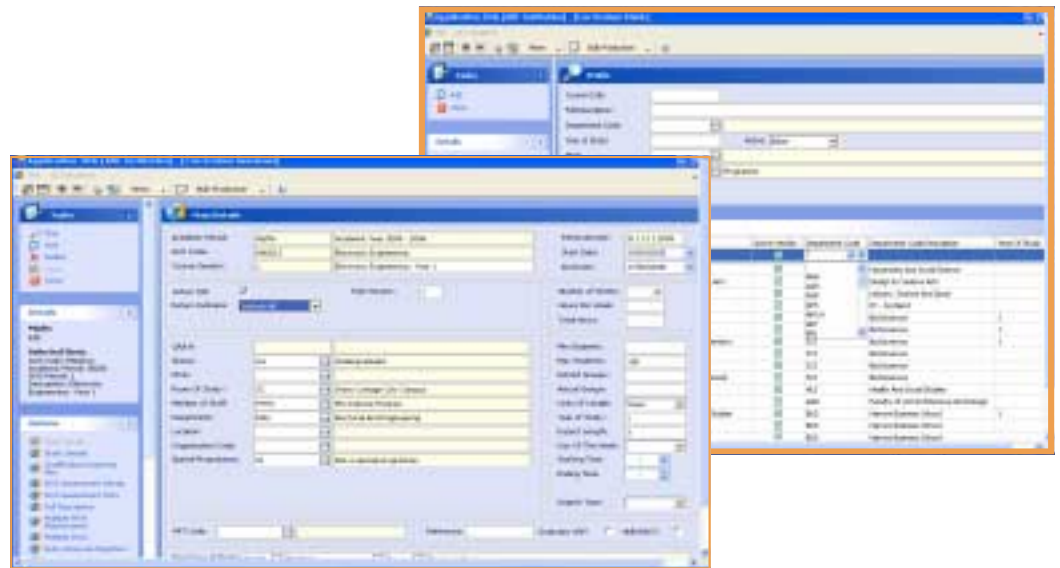

Agresso provides a sophisticated curriculum management system designed so that the Institution can readily develop the curriculum to suit its own individual needs.

The evolution of the curriculum structure to modular qualification aims means that a modular curriculum management system is more than desirable, it is essential.

This approach provides clearly defined learning pathways which can cater for the requirements of the student, the Institution and any external bodies.

Agresso Students offers a truly modular flexible curriculum structure allowing each Institution to tailor the system to fit its requirements. All necessary information can be recorded including qualification aim(s), fee details, dates and length at any level of the hierarchy.



Such is the flexibility of the curriculum that any possible combination an Institution wishes to offer can be accommodated. This can include defining multiple occurrences of the same area of study with different start/end dates or maybe the same course leading to different qualification aims.

Agresso Students uses a single curriculum throughout the whole application and it is therefore paramount that the curriculum holds key information that filters to other areas of Agresso Students as needed. It offers the ability to link internal courses to UCAS codes, providing an Institution with the ability to track students from admissions through to graduation.

Course Regulations

Regulations associated with a course can be reflected within the curriculum structure and hence available when students enrol. Defining core modules, pre and co requisites, along with valid subject combinations are just some of the rules available.

Course structures are different at each Institution and it is for this reason that Agresso Students offers the facility to structure its courses with great flexibility. Courses can be of a linear nature or they could consist of its constituent parts, such as subjects, diets and modules.

The option to define flexible structures is key to any curriculum offering.

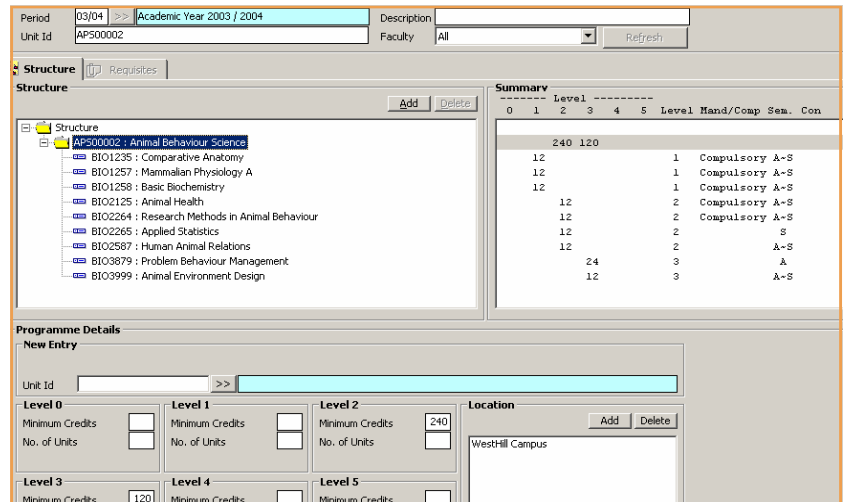
Course pathways are created by providing a hierarchy to the course.

Pre and Co Requisites

Agresso Students has the option of specifying two types of pre and co requisites.

Absolute — this is related to the module regardless of the course structure. A module can be defined as having been just studied or studied and passed.

Relative — This is when the pre / co requisite is dependant on the course structure.



Module Structures

Modules can be created within Agresso Students with their own unique properties, such as level, credit value, length and dates. Once a module has been defined it can be flagged as being offered in a single semester, multiple or across semesters without the need to create multiple module codes. The assessable components can be viewed against the module (shown below).



Once a module has been defined, they can be related to any course structure. The properties of the module are inherent, however the rules are dependent on the course pathway. Therefore the same module could be core in one structure, but optional in another.

Course Rollover

Although course structures can change every year to reflect the Institution's new regulations, the core offerings remain the same. Agresso Students offers the provision to rollover the course structures from one academic year to the next, with the capability of amending any information where appropriate.

Statistics

As a bi-product of the admission and student enrolment process, Agresso Students supply on-line statistics against all courses, subjects and modules. This provides high level statistics with regard to current admissions and current enrolments, however it also offers an on-line detailed analysis of the Institution defined statuses, such as conditional offer, reject, withdrawn and transferred.
