



Course Aim

The aim of the ODBC technical review is to enable the customer to install and configure the software in order to gain access to the data held within the Sculptor table from PC's running ODBC compliant software.

Pre-requisites

Attendance on the AIX Technical Course is desirable, though not essential. A working knowledge of Microsoft Access is preferred.

Suggested Attendees

This course is designed for support staff who are required to produce reports outside of the Report Generator.

Course Content

- **Introduction to ODBC**
An explanation of the standard, concepts and components of the ODBC software.
- **Installation**
A step-by-step process of how to install both the client component software and the server component software.
- **Configuration**
The set-up of the server software, how to create universal data dictionaries and the various server commands utilised to produce this. The correct set-up of the client software.
- **Practical**
Exercises in order to create data sources on the server and how to connect to these sources from the PC.
- **Network**
Basic problem solving and connection basics.
- **Typical Problems**
Steps to take to identify and solve problems and support issues.

Course Objectives

On completion of this course, the delegate should be able to install the ODBC drivers to gain access to the data tables required.

The course provides a practical "hands on" approach & tutorials to various aspects of the ODBC connection.
